

**Wednesday in Passion Week,
28th March, 7.00 pm.
in Christ Church, Strathalbyn.**

The service of Tenebrae, meaning “darkness” or “shadows,” has been practised since medieval times.

Once a service for the monastic community, Tenebrae later became an important part of the worship of the common folk during Holy Week. We join Christians of many generations throughout the world in using the liturgy of Tenebrae.

Tenebrae is a prolonged meditation on Christ’s suffering. It is often held earlier in Passion week to enable us to journey with Jesus, listen and reflect, as the shadows approach and he prepares for his path of suffering.

Readings are from the psalms and gospels, music portrays his pathos, and the power of silence and darkness evoke the drama of the approaching sacrifice.

As lights are extinguished, we ponder the depth of Christ’s suffering and death; and through the return of the small but persistent flame of the Christ candle at the conclusion of the service, we anticipate the joy of his ultimate triumph
